The applicant must be currently attending one of these universities on a full time basis (12 units or more per semester/quarter) or; is a Hispanic student graduating in June 2014 from a Sacramento area senior high school and formally accepted for admission in the Fall of 2014 at one of these universities. Applicants must also possess a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 for course work completed (at the university or high school; whichever is applicable). A selection panel comprised of three board members of the Mexican Cultural Center Board review the applications with supportive materials, interview the qualified candidates and then select the grant winner.
